

How To Build a Themed Party Curriculum

1. Confirm theme, age of birthday kid, age range of guests, and what type of structure the birthday parents want.
 - a. Are the activities focused around birthday kid's age or age range of guests?
 - b. Do they want more free play or more structure?
2. Choose age-appropriate activities from the requested theme and plan your themed announcements.
 - a. Activities are sorted by Parent Participation (1-3years) vs. Independent (4-10years). Can choose some activities from both sections to best fit the age range of children attending.
3. Ensure you have the proper equipment set up for each planned activity.
 - a. Anything underlined is searchable in MGM curriculum center where you can find equipment needed and example themed announcements. (Feel free to get creative with your announcements!)

EXAMPLE DINOSAUR PARTY

(Birthday kid 2yo, guests age range 1-7yo, parents want activities for all ages)

Announce that parents need to be on floor with kiddos 4 and under

1:30 - Coming In

1:45 - Circle/Rules into → Dinosaur Freeze Dance (Kiboomers)

2:00 - Dino Safari Tour (Obstacle Course around blue circle) PLUS Dinosaur Train (Train big deal on blue line)

2:15 - Dino's Nest (Chicken Coop in blue circle) PLUS Stomp Like a Dinosaur - Stilts (Skill station on blue line)

2:30 - What Time is it T. Rex? - Mr. Fox With dino puppet (Game)

2:40 - Fly like a Pterodactyl (sky saucer skill station) PLUS Walk Across the Iguanodon (hotdog skill station)

2:55 - Shake Up the Dino Eggs - Parachute with gator balls

3:00 - Food!
